

# If you are injured at work...

# 1

## **Tell Your Employer**

*details of your injury*

After receiving notice, your employer must report your injury to WCB within 72 hours if:

- you need medical treatment beyond first aid, or
- you cannot do your job beyond the day of accident.

# 2

## **Tell Your Health Care Provider**

*you were injured at work*

Your doctor or Chiropractor must report your injury to WCB within 48 hours.

# 3

## **Tell WCB**

*Send your Report of Injury form to WCB right away!*
