

# Interdisciplinary Return to Work (RTW) Services

## Assessment Services

Assessment Services are designed to provide a menu of return to work assessment options to evaluate the worker's medical, musculoskeletal, functional, psychosocial, and vocational status in order to triage the worker into the most appropriate rehabilitation intervention pathway to facilitate safe, sustainable return to work and claim closure.

## Interdisciplinary Return to Work Services

Interdisciplinary return to work services bring together a team of professionals to address the unique needs of workers. The resulting customized programs focus on maximizing functional restoration and return to work capabilities. Services may be delivered at the provider site, worksite or a combination of both.

## Specialized Return to Work Services

**Complex Program** – targeted for workers with highly complex RTW barriers.

**Traumatic Psychological Injury Program** – targeted for workers with a diagnosis of traumatic psychological injury.

## Vocational Services

Vocational Services are designed to address the return to work needs of the worker to facilitate suitable, accessible, sustainable employment that maximizes the worker's earnings and supports claim closure. Vocational Services may be delivered as part of an integrated RTW program or as a stand alone service depending on the circumstances of each case.
