

If you are injured at work...

1

Tell Your Employer

details of your injury

After receiving notice, your employer must report your injury to WCB within 72 hours if:

- you need medical treatment beyond first aid, or
- you cannot do your job beyond the day of accident.

2

Tell Your Health Care Provider

you were injured at work

Your doctor or Chiropractor must report your injury to WCB within 48 hours.

3

Tell WCB

Send your Report of Injury form to WCB right away!

Avoid delays. Report early!
