Occupational Injury Service Provincial Employer Report

Purpose of Report:

The report summarizes utilization of the Occupational Injury Service and characteristics of claims compared to other enrolled companies and, where applicable, to non-enrolled companies.

Key Measures and Concepts

Inclusion Criteria:

Claims are included if the date of accident is in the report period. For companies that enrolled after the start of the report period, only claims after the enrollment date are included.

All claims charged to the enrolled account are included.

Total Claims: all claims charged to the employer account.

N with at least one OIS visit: the number of claims that have at least one paid OIS visit.

% with at least one OIS visit: the number of claims with at least one paid OIS visit divided by the total claims.

Types of Claims

NTL: no time loss claims without modified work indicated.

NTL with Modified: no time loss (no compensation costs) but with modified work indicated.

LTC with Modified: time loss claims (compensation costs) with modified work indicated.

LTC no Modified: time loss claims (compensation costs) without modified work indicated.

% with Modified Work (LTC + NTL): of the total claims, the percentage NTL with Modified and LTC Modified.

Total Temporary Disability (TD01) Status

% At Full or Modified 7 Days After Last Visit: determines if the claim was receiving Total Temporary Disability (TD01) benefits 7 days after the last visit to the OIS clinic for claims seen at OIS, and for all claims types including NTL claims. The measure shows the percentage not receiving TD01, i.e., at full or modified duties.

Average Total Temporary Disability Calendar Days in the first 90 Days post accident (All Claims): the total number of TD01 calendar days in the first 90 days post accident averaged across all claims including NTL. Claims seen at OIS and those not seen at OIS are included.

OIS Visit Characteristics

Average Number of Visits: the average number of paid visits to the OIS clinic.

% with only 1 visit: the percentage of claims with only one paid visit.

Average Days from First Visit to Last Visit: the average number of days for claims with at least one visit, from first to last visit. Claims with only 1 visit have a value of 1.

Claims Costs (All Claims)

To enable comparisons over time and between different employers, only the compensation and health care costs incurred in the first 90 days after day of accident are included.

Average Health Care Costs in first 90 days: all medical aid costs with a service date in the first 90 days post accident.

Average Compensation Costs in the first 90 days: all compensation costs (including TD01 and other cost type 1) with a payment from date in the first 90 days.

Reporting (OIS Claims)

The average calendar days from date of accident to the WCB 'received' date for the Worker Report and Employer Report
