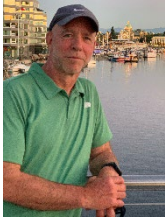

Dr. Lowell Van Zuiden, MD, FRCSC, MBA, is a semi-retired orthopedic surgeon who is currently doing musculoskeletal and orthopedic assessments at the Alberta Hip and Knee Clinic and some assisting in the operating room for colleagues from the clinic. He received a BAsC in mechanical engineering from the University of Waterloo in 1972 and graduated from McMaster University's medical school in 1976. He completed an orthopedic residency at the University of Calgary in 1981 and an arthroplasty and spinal research fellowship at Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre at the University of Oxford in the United Kingdom. He obtained an MBA from the Haskayne School of Business in 2002.

He was chief of Orthopedics for the Calgary District Hospital Group and chief of surgery for the Calgary District Hospital Group and Calgary Health Region.
